SUBJECT: BCD Command Policy Letter #04 - Army Substance Abuse Program (ASAP)

1. Reference:
  - a. AR 600-85, Army Substance Abuse Program, 28 November 2016.
  - b. 19th BCD ASAP SOP
2. Purpose: To establish guidelines for random drug testing of Soldiers assigned or attached to the 19th BCD.
3. General. Abuse of alcohol or other use of illicit drugs by both military and civilian personnel is inconsistent with Army Values, the Warrior Ethos, and the standards of performance, discipline and readiness necessary to accomplish the Army's mission.
4. Violators of the Army Regulations governing substance abuse and use of illicit drugs are punishable under UCMJ.
5. UPLs will adhere to the testing guidelines outlined in the BCD ASAP SOP.
