MEMORANDUM FOR DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: BCD Command Policy Letter #03 - Prevention of Sexual Assault and Harassment

1. There is no place for sexual assault or harassment in the 19th Battlefield Coordination Detachment. All members of the community - Soldiers, Airmen, civilians, dependents, and local nationals - must at all times be treated with dignity and respect.
2. Sexual Assault refers to offenses of a sexual nature committed without the lawful consent of the victim. These offenses, which are punishable as crimes under UCMJ, include rape, forcible sodomy, indecent assault, and carnal knowledge
3. Sexual Harassment. Sexual harassment includes unsolicited or unwelcome verbal comments, gestures, humiliation, embarrassment, or physical contact of a sexual nature. It also includes actively or implicitly using coercive sexual behavior to control, influence, or affect the career or job of a subordinate or another member of the community.
4. Prevention. Leaders at all levels will train and mentor their subordinates in order to create an understanding of and intolerance for sexual assault and harassment.
5. Immediate Response. Those who are a victim of an act of sexual assault or harassment should immediately report the incident to the unit Sexual Assault Response Coordinator (SARC), Detachment Victims' Advocate, or, if necessary, to other agencies such as the military police. The chain of command will respond immediately to deal with all allegations, with an emphasis on protecting the rights of victims. Soldiers who witness an act of sexual assault or harassment must report it immediately to the unit chain of command and SARC.
6. Retaliatory Behavior. The use of social media to engage in such behavior, separately addressing on-duty and off-duty behavior and may be punishable under the UCMJ; and that sexual harassment, sexual assault, and retaliatory behavior are incompatible with Army values.
7. Long-term Support. Leaders will ensure that victims receive the support that they need to effectively recover from the physical and mental health effects that often accompany these heinous acts.
